Yahshua, the Father manifested in flesh!

Yahshua made a remarkable declaration in John 8:24,

Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am (He), you will die in your sins.”

The Greek words that are translated as “I am” are *EGO EIMI* (I AM). Note that the word (*He*) is **not** in the original Greek text but was added by translators. John 8:24 is accurately read as follows,

Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I AM, you will die in your sins.”

Yahshua declares that **He** is the “I AM”, the Almighty Father of the Old Testament! (Exodus 3:14). Thirty four verses later, Yahshua repeats His declaration that **He** is the Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

Jesus (Yahshua) said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.” John 8:58

Once again, the Greek words that are translated “I AM” in this verse are *EGO EIMI*.

Yahshua clearly declares in John 8:24 that a person who wants cleansing from sin must believe that **He** is the “I AM” of the Old Testament; the Almighty Father manifested in flesh to shed **His** blood for us.

I AM

The **Almighty Father** declares **Himself** “I AM” in the Old Testament.

Yahshua declares **Himself** “I AM” in the New Testament.

The Apostle John records **many** times when Yahshua refers to **Himself** as being “I AM”. “I AM” was known by the Hebrews to be the name the Almighty gave to Moses in Exodus 3:14.

Yahshua, the Messiah (the Son of God) declared that **He** is the “I AM” of the Old Testament. When Yahshua said He is “I AM”, He proclaimed that **He** is the **Almighty Father** manifested in flesh to be the Savior of His people.

In the Gospel of John, John writes of **eight** instances where Yahshua refers to **Himself** as “I AM”. In the book of Revelation, John writes of seven instances where Yahshua refers to **Himself** as “I AM”.

Did you know the disciples attributed the titles of the Almighty Father... to Yahshua!

All the saints and all the preachers in the first century Church understood who Yahshua was and who He claimed to be. “God with us.” They understood that Yahshua was **the Almighty Father** incarnate. The Almighty had always taught the Jewish

people to be monotheistic, so they knew this meant Yahshua was the Father come down from heaven in the body of a man.

The apostle John referred to Yahshua as the *“the first and the last”* (Revelation 1:17; 2:8; 22:13); *“the true light”* (John 1:9); the *“bridegroom”* (Revelation 21:2); *“Savior of the world”* (John 4:42; cf. Isaiah 43:3-11). He also attributed to Yahshua the role of *“Redeemer”* in Revelation 5:9.

The apostle Peter called Yahshua the *“rock”* and *“stone”* (1 Peter 2:6-8; Psalms 18:2; 95:1); and *“the Chief Shepherd”* (1 Peter 5:4). The apostle Paul referred to Yahshua as the *“rock”* (1 Corinthians 10:4) and the *“bridegroom”* (Ephesians 5:22-33).

The Old Testament role of *‘Redeemer’* (Hosea 13:14; Psalms 130:7) is given to Yahshua, by Paul in Titus 2:13-14.

Yahshua, is the forgiver of sins in Colossians 3:13 and He is *“Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead.”* (2 Timothy 4:1)

What is so special about these titles?

All of these titles are unique to the Almighty Father in the Old Testament but are given to Yahshua in the New Testament!

The disciples were steeped in the Old Testament and would have only applied these titles with great care. If they did not think Yahshua, the Messiah was the Almighty manifested in flesh, they would have never used these words to describe him.

**The disciples considered Yahshua
to be the Almighty Father, who came in the flesh.**

The New Testament opens with a passage concluding that Yahshua, is Immanuel (*“God with us”*), which refers to the messianic prediction of Isaiah 7:14.

Again, since the Jewish people were taught to be strictly monotheistic, and knowing there is only one true Almighty, they knew this was none other than the Father.

In the New Testament, the Apostles present Yahshua as the Almighty Father “manifested in the flesh” (1 Timothy 3:16).

When Thomas said to Yahshua, *“My Lord and my God!”*; are we to believe that Thomas was not also proclaiming Yahshua to be the Almighty Father?

And... what about the apostle Paul, who called Yahshua...

“our great God and Savior.”

Titus 2:13

Or, of Peter who tells us...

“This faith was given to you because of the justice and fairness of Jesus Christ (Yahshua the Messiah) our God and Savior.”

2 Peter 1:1

*There is but One Almighty...
and His name is Yahshua!*

If I told you there is no such thing as a Trinity mentioned in the Bible, you might become offended. But you must understand that this is not a sacrilegious statement. This is a statement of fact and it's true based on the Holy scriptures and the concept of the oneness of the Almighty (Deuteronomy 4:35, 39; 6:4; 32:39; Isaiah 41:4; 42:8; 43:3-11, 10-13; 44:6, 8, 24; 45:5, 6, 15, 21, 22, 23; 46:8, 9; 47:4; 48:12; 49:26; 52:6).

The Almighty says that He is one...

Deuteronomy 6:4

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one!

Malachi 2:10

Have we not all one Father? Has not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously with one another by profaning the covenant of the fathers?

Mark 12:28-29

Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him,

"Which is the first commandment of all?"

Yahshua answered him,

*"The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel,
the LORD our God, the LORD is one."*

1 Corinthians 8:4-6

yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus (Yahshua) Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

Ephesians 4:5-6

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

1 Timothy 2:5

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus (Yahshua),

James 2:19

You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe - and tremble!

Revelation 4:2, 3

Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne. And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.

Yahshua is the Almighty Father manifest in flesh!

Ephesians 4:6 tells us there is “*one God and Father of all*”. Since we know Yahshua is God, we know He is the Father.

Here is additional biblical proof that Yahshua is the Father.

1. Isaiah prophesied that the “Son” who was to come would be called “**Mighty God**” and “**Everlasting Father**”. (Isaiah 9:6) Yahshua was the prophesied Son in His humanity, but He is our **Mighty God** and **Father** in His deity.
1. Colossians 2:9 proclaims that all the fullness of Deity dwells in Yahshua. This includes the role of Father, so the Father must dwell in Yahshua.
2. In addition to these two verses, Yahshua Himself taught that He was the Father. Once, when Yahshua was talking about the Father, the Pharisees asked, “Where is Your Father?” Yahshua answered, “You know neither Me nor My Father. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also.” (John 8:19).

As previously discussed, Yahshua went on to say, “Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am **[He]*, you will die in your sins.” (John 8:24).

* We should note that the '*He*' in verse John 8:24 is in italics, which indicates that it is not in the original Greek, but was added by the translators. Yahshua is saying He is the "I AM" of Exodus 3:14.

3. In another place Yahshua said, "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30).

Some try to say that He was one with the Father much as a husband and wife are one, or as two men can be one in agreement. This interpretation attempts to weaken the force of the assertion Yahshua made.

However, other verses fully support that Yahshua was not only the Son in His humanity but also the Father in His deity.

4. For example, Yahshua stated in John 12:45, "And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me." In other words, if a person sees Yahshua as to His deity, he sees the Father.

5. In John 14:7 Yahshua told His disciples, "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him." Upon hearing this statement, Philip requested, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." (John 14:8).

In other words, he asked that Yahshua show them the Father and then they would be satisfied.

Yahshua's answer was, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? **He who has seen Me has seen the Father**, so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. "Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. (John 14:9-11).

This statement goes far beyond a relationship of agreement; it can be viewed as nothing less than the claim of Christ being the Father manifested in flesh.

Like many people today, Philip had not comprehended that *the Father is an invisible Spirit* and that the only way a person could ever see Him would be through the person of Yahshua, the Messiah. "*God was manifested in the flesh*" (1 Timothy 3:16).

6. Yahshua said, "The Father is in me, and I in Him" (John 10:38).
7. Yahshua promised to be the Father of all over-comers (Revelation 21:6-7).
8. In John 14:18 Yahshua said, "I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you." The Greek word translated "comfortless" is orphanos, which Strong's Exhaustive Concordance defines as "bereaved ('orphans'), i.e. parentless." Yahshua was saying, "I will not leave you as orphans" (NIV and TAB), or "I will not leave you fatherless: I will come to you." Yahshua, speaking as the Father, promised that He would not leave His disciples fatherless.

Below are some comparisons which provide additional proof that Yahshua is the Father.

9. Yahshua prophesied that He would resurrect His own body from the dead in three days (John 2:19-21), yet Peter preached that God raised up Yahshua from the dead (Acts 2:24).

10. Yahshua said He would send the Comforter to us (John 16:7), but He also said the Father would send the Comforter. (John 14:26)

11. The Father alone can draw men (John 6:44), yet Yahshua said He would draw all men (John 12:32).

12. Yahshua will raise up all believers at the last day (John 6:40), yet the Father quickens (gives life to) the dead and will raise us up (Romans 4:17; 1 Corinthians 6:14).

13. Yahshua promised to answer the believer's prayer (John 14:14), yet He said the Father would answer prayer.(John 16:23)

14. Christ is our sanctifier (Ephesians 5:26), yet the Father sanctifies us (Jude 1).

15. 1 John 3:1, 5: states that ***the Father loved us and was manifested to take away our sins.*** 1 Timothy 3:16 states, ***“God was manifested in the flesh,”*** yet we know it was Yahshua who was manifested in the world to take away sin (John 1:29-31)

We can easily understand all of this if we realize that Yahshua has a dual nature. He is both Spirit and flesh, the Almighty and man, Father and Son. On His human side He is the Son of man; on His divine side He is the Son of God and is the Father dwelling in flesh.

***He who has seen Me
has seen the Father***

John 14:9

Scriptures show that Yahshua **is** the Father

Isaiah 9:6 clearly reveals to us that Yahshua **is** the **son**, **is** the **Holy Spirit**, **is** the **Everlasting Father** and **is** our **Mighty God!**

*For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a **Son** is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, **Counselor**, **Mighty God**, **Everlasting Father**, Prince of Peace.*

Isaiah 9:6

The Bible clearly tells us there is One Lord, One God the Father.

*yet for us there is but **one God**, **the Father**, from whom are all things and we exist for Him; and one Lord, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we exist through Him.*

1 Corinthians 8:6

*one Lord, one faith, one baptism; **one God and Father of all**, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.*

Ephesians 4:5-6

The Apostle Thomas proclaimed...

*And Thomas answered and said to Him,
"My **Lord** and my **God!**"*

John 20:28

Thomas, speaking to Yahshua... proclaims Yahshua **Lord!**

Thomas, speaking to Yahshua... proclaims Yahshua **God!**

And notice... Yahshua does not correct Thomas in what he says!

yet for us there is but one God, the Father

1 Corinthians 8:6

Yahshua ***is*** the Almighty Father of the Old Testament!

*“... and you shall call His name Jesus (Yahshua),
for He will save His people from their sins.”*

Matthew 1:21

What love and grace it was when the great Creator of the whole universe, and who is beyond all human description, took a name in human language by which He could be known.

At just the right time the Almighty Father, ***Himself*** came to save us. He came to help us in a human body...to do for us, what we could not do for ourselves!

Specific instructions were given to Joseph in a dream by an angel: ***'Call his name Yahshua.'***

The name "Yahshua" is so important to us because it is an expanded form of the same divine name (Yah) revealed in the Old Testament! It is not a different name; it is greater in that it more fully expresses who the Almighty is to us - Savior!

The New Covenant in the Holy Bible teaches that **Yahshua is the name above all names.** There is no name higher than Yahshua.

Yahshua ***is*** the Almighty manifested in flesh!

*... **God** was manifested in the flesh...*

1 Timothy 3:16

Look at the following scriptures and you will clearly see that Yahshua is the Almighty Father of The Old Testament manifested in flesh!

Every Knee Shall Bow to Yah

Isaiah 45:5-6, 22-23

I am the LORD, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, That they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting That there is none besides Me. I am the LORD, and there is no other;

Look to Me, and be saved, All you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other. I have sworn by Myself; The word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, And shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, Every tongue shall take an oath.

Every Knee Shall Bow to Yahshua

Romans 14:11

For it is written: "As I live, says the LORD, Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God."

Philippians 2:10-11

that at the name of Jesus (Yahshua) every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus (Yahshua) Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

The Father Will Send The Comforter

John 14:26

"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

Yahshua Will Send The Comforter

John 16:7

Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.

Yah is Coming

Zechariah 14:4-5

And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, Which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, From east to west, Making a very large valley; Half of the mountain shall move toward the north And half of it toward the south. Then you shall flee through My mountain valley, For the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. Yes, you shall flee As you fled from the earthquake In the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Thus the LORD my God will come, And all the saints with You.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. For if we believe that Yahshua died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Yahshua. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

Revelations 19:11, 16

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Yahshua is Coming

1 Thessalonians 3:11-13

Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus (Yahshua) Christ, direct our way to you. And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus (Yahshua) Christ with all His saints.

Matthew 25:31

When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.

Titus 2:11-13

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus (Yahshua) Christ,

Yah the Creator

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 2:7

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Psalms 33:6

By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

Psalms 104:30-31

You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; and You renew the face of the earth... May the LORD rejoice in His works.

Isaiah 40:28

Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.

Isaiah 44:24

Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, And He who formed you from the womb: "I *am* the LORD, who makes all things, Who stretches out the heavens **all alone**, Who spreads abroad the **earth by Myself**;

Isaiah 45:11-12

I have made the earth, And created man on it. I—My hands—stretched out the heavens, And all their host I have commanded.

Malachi 2:10

Have we not all **one Father**? Has not **one God created us**?

Now look at the following scriptures which proclaim Yahshua is the Creator!

Yahshua the Creator

John 1:10

He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

1 Corinthians 8:6

But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus (Yahshua) Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

Colossians 1:15-16

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible... All things were created through Him and for Him.

Revelation 4:11

You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power: for you created all things, And by your will they exist and were created.

Revelation 10:6

and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer.

Revelation 14:7

Saying with a loud voice, “Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment is come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea springs of water.”

Revelation 21:5-7

Then He who sat on the throne said, “Behold, I make all things new.” And He said to me, “Write, for these words are true and faithful.” And He said to me, “It is done! **I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End.** *I will give of the fountain of the *water of life freely to him who thirsts.* He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and **I will be his God and he shall be My son.**

** Jesus (Yahshua) answered and said to her, “Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, “but whoever drinks of the water that **I shall give him** will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.” John 4:13-14*

All Things Were Created for Yah

The LORD hath made all things for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil (Proverbs 16:4).

All Things Were Created for Yahshua

But the Apostle Paul wrote the following about Yahshua:

For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; **all things were created by him and for him**.

Colossians 1:16

The Almighty raised Yahshua from the dead

Acts 2:24

Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.

Yahshua raised Himself from the dead

John 2:19-21

Jesus (Yahshua) answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days **I will raise it up**. Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? But he spake of the temple of his body.

The Father draws men to Himself

John 6:44

"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

Yahshua draws men to Himself

John 12:32

"And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself."

The Almighty is the Father

Malachi 2:10

Have we not all one Father? Has not one God created us?

I Corinthians 8:6

yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom *are* all things, and through whom we live.

Yahshua is the Father

For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

I Corinthians 8:6 tells us that, "*for us there is one God, the Father,...*"

There is no Almighty outside of the Father. Since Yahshua is *the Almighty, Yahshua is the Father.

* "**I am** the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." Yahshua... Revelation 1:8

Finally, let's look at Revelation 21:5-7, which clearly shows us that Yahshua is the Father.

Starting at verse 5 it reads: *And **He who sits on the throne** said, "Behold, I am making all things new (we are made new by being in Christ - 2 Corinthians 5:17). And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true" (in Revelation 3:14 and 19:11 Yahshua is called "faithful and true").*

Revelation 21:6 *And He said to me, "It is done!" (Compare to John 19:30, "It is finished!") I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end.*

His next sentence... *"I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. (Yahshua gives the water of life, John 4:10-14; Revelation 7:17.*

Revelation 21:7 - *He who overcomes (Yahshua spoke these words seven times to each of the seven churches in the beginning of this epistle, 2:7,11,17,26; 3:5,12, 21) will inherit these things, and I will be his God **and he will be My son**".*

Everything in this passage points towards Yahshua as the speaker, yet at the end of the passage we realize it is **the Father**.

Yah is the First and Last

According to the following, the *First* and the *Last* is YHWH (Yah-weh), the *Almighty*:

Isaiah 44:6

This is what the LORD says - Israel's King and Redeemer, **the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last**; apart from me there is no God.

Isaiah 48:12

Listen to me, O Jacob, Israel, whom I have called: **I am he; I am the first and I am the last.**

Yahshua is the First and Last

Yet Yahshua calls himself, “**the First and the Last**,” in the New Testament:

When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last.

Revelation 1:17

To the angel of the church in Smyrna write: These are the words of him who is the First and the Last, who died and came to life again.

Revelation 2:8

"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, **the First and the Last.**"

Revelation 22:13

Yah alone forgives sin

The Old Testament Scriptures are abundantly clear that YAH alone forgives sin...

If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You, That You may be feared.

Psalm 130:3,4

"I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins.

Isaiah 43:25

"I have blotted out, like a thick cloud, your transgressions, And like a cloud, your sins. Return to Me, for I have redeemed you."

Isaiah 44:22

Yahshua forgives sins

and yet... Yahshua personally forgave the sins of the poor paralytic.

When Jesus (Yahshua) saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven you.”

Mark 2:5

And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, “Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins **but God alone?**”

Luke 5:21

Yah, the 'I AM' and the 'I AM HE'

Exodus 3:13-14

Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?" And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

Isaiah 41:4

Who has performed and done it, Calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am the first; And with the last I am He.'

Isaiah 43:10-11

"You are My witnesses," says the LORD, "And My servant whom I have chosen, That you may know and believe Me, And understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God formed, Nor shall there be after Me. I, even I, am the LORD, And besides Me there is no savior.

Yahshua, the 'I AM' and the 'I AM HE'

Yahshua shocked the unbelieving Jewish leaders when He identified Himself as Yahweh, the Almighty Father of the Old Testament. Yahshua told them that **He** was the “**I AM**” who appeared to Moses in Exodus 3:13,14.

John 8:58

Yahshua said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.”

Revelation 1:17-18

Yah is the King

Psalm 24

Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.

Psalm 44:4

You are my King, O God; Command victories for Jacob.

Psalm 74:12

For God is my King from of old, Working salvation in the midst of the earth.

Isaiah 43:15

I am the LORD, your Holy One, The Creator of Israel, your King.

Isaiah 44:6-8

This is what the LORD says— Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.

Yahshua is the King

Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus (Yahshua) answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

John 19:21-22

Therefore the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, “Do not write, ‘The King of the Jews,’ but, ‘He said, “I am the King of the Jews.”” Pilate answered, “What I have written, I have written.”

1 Timothy 6:15

which He will manifest in His own time, He who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords,

Revelations 15:1-4

They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: “Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints!

Revelations 19:11, 16

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Yah is Lord of lords

In Deuteronomy 10:17, we read:

For **the LORD your God** is God of gods and **Lord of lords**, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality and accepts no bribes

Note: according to the Old Testament Scripture, YHWH is *Lord of lords*.

Yahshua is Lord of lords

Yet in the New Testament we clearly read that Yahshua is *Lord of lords*:

They will make war against **the Lamb**, but the Lamb will overcome them because he **is Lord of lords** and King of kings - and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers. (Revelation 17:14)

Furthermore, the New Testament reveals that the King of kings and **Lord of lords is the Almighty**:

which God will bring about in his own time - **God**, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords. (1 Timothy 6:15)

Was Yah ever pierced?

Next, let's consider who was pierced. In the New Testament, we read the following about Yahshua:

One of the soldiers, however, pierced his side with a spear, and immediately blood and water flowed out. (This report is from an eyewitness giving an accurate account. He speaks the truth so that you also can believe. These things happened in fulfillment of the Scriptures that say, "Not one of his bones will be broken," and "They will look on the one they pierced."

John 19:34-37

The only Scripture that John could have been referring to when he wrote, "... as another scripture says, 'They will look on the one they have **pierced**' " is the following one:

And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. They **will look on me, the one they have pierced**, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him as one grieves for a firstborn son (Zachariah 12:10).

YHWH spoke those words through the prophet Zechariah, as is apparent as we read from Zechariah 12:1 down through verse 10.

Yahshua was pierced

YHWH (Yah-weh) is speaking and uses the word **me** in conjunction to being the one that gets pierced. Yet, the Apostle John referred to the same Scripture (Zechariah 12:10) and says that ***it was fulfilled when Yahshua was pierced*** on the cross by the Roman soldier's spear!

Who was *pierced*, Yah or Yahshua?

Since Yahshua ***is*** Yah... this puzzle is solved.

*The Father gives life to the dead
and will raise us up*

Romans 4:17

That is what the Scriptures mean when God told him, “I have made you the father of many nations.” This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing.

I Corinthians 6:14

And God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power.

*Yahshua will raise up all believers
in the last day*

John 6:40

“And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.”

Yah is the Rock

Deuteronomy 32:3-4

For I proclaim the name of the LORD: Ascribe greatness to our God. He is the Rock, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.

2 Samuel 22:2-3; 32

And he said: "The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence....For who is God, except the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God?"

Psalm 18:2

The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 31:3

Yah is the Almighty Savior

The Apostle Paul cites the promise of Joel in the Old Testament that...

“whoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be saved”

Joel 2:32

and applies it directly to the salvation of the person in the New Testament who calls on the name of Yahshua.

*Whoever shall call on the Lord Jesus
(Yahshua) shall be saved*

that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus (Yahshua) and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.... For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”

Romans 10:9, 10,13

Yah saved His people out of the land of Egypt

Exodus 13:18

So God led the people around by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea. And the children of Israel went up in orderly ranks *out of the land of Egypt.*

Numbers 21:5

And the people spoke *against God* and Moses: “*Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness?* For there is no food and no water, and our soul loathes this worthless bread.”

Deuteronomy 1:31

and *in the wilderness* where you saw *how the LORD your God carried you*, as a man carries his son, in all the way that you went until you came to this place.'

Deuteronomy 2:7

“For the LORD your God has blessed you in all the work of your hand. He knows your trudging through this great wilderness. *These forty years the LORD your God has been with you;* you have lacked nothing.”

Acts 13:17

The *God* of this people Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers *in the land of Egypt*, and *with an uplifted arm He brought them out of it.*

Yahshua saved His people out of the land of Egypt

But I want to remind you, though you once knew this, that the **Lord**, having *saved the people out of the land of Egypt*, afterward destroyed those who did not believe. NKJV

1 Corinthians 10:1-4

I don't want you to forget, dear brothers and sisters, about our ancestors in the wilderness long ago. All of them were guided by a cloud that moved ahead of them, and all of them walked through the sea on dry ground. In the cloud and in the sea, all of them were baptized as followers of Moses. All of them ate the same spiritual food, and all of them drank the same spiritual water. For they drank from the spiritual rock that traveled with them, ***and that rock was Christ***. Yet God was not pleased with most of them, and their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.

see "Rock" - Deuteronomy 32:4, 15, 18, 30-31, 37

This Rock was specifically referred to in the Old Testament:

"And they remembered *that God was their rock*,
And *the Most High God their Redeemer*."

Psalm 78:35

Yah is our Shepherd

Psalm 23

A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Isaiah 40:10-11

Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong hand, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him. He will feed His flock like a shepherd; He will gather the lambs with His arm, And carry them in His bosom, And gently lead those who are with young.

Psalm 100:3

Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Yahshua is our Shepherd

John 10:8-12

Make the way straight for Yah

Isaiah 40:3

Matthew 3:3

For **this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah,**

saying: “The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of **the LORD**; Make **His** paths straight.’ ”

*The Almighty,
“A stone that causes men to stumble”*

Compare Isaiah 8:13,14 to what the Apostle Peter wrote. The following is the passage from Isaiah:

The LORD Almighty is the one you are to regard as holy, he is the one you are to fear, he is the one you are to dread, and he will be a sanctuary; but for both houses of Israel he will be a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall. And for the people of Jerusalem he will be a trap and a snare (Isaiah 8:13,14).

Question:

Did Isaiah the prophet say that LORD Almighty will be a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall?

Clearly he did.

Why then do we read the following about **Yahshua**?

Yahshua,
“A stone that causes men to stumble”

Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, “The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone,” and, “**A stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall.**” They stumble because they disobey the message - which is also what they were destined for.

1 Peter 2:7,8

Acts 4:11-12

“This is the ‘stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.’ “Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

Is the Almighty Father, or Yahshua, a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall?

Or, why did the Apostle Peter refer to a Scripture that was written about the Almighty Father... and apply it to Yahshua?

Are all these contradictions?

Certainly not! Because Yahshua was the Almighty Father manifest in flesh!

The children of Israel tempted the Almighty

Exodus 17:7

So he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah, because of the contention of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, “Is the LORD among us or not?”

Psalm 78:41

Yes, again and again they tempted God, And limited the Holy One of Israel.

Numbers 21:6

And the LORD *sent fiery serpents* among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died.

The children of Israel tempted Christ

1 Corinthians 10:9 NKJV

Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents.

1 Corinthians 10:9 NLT

Nor should we put Christ to the test, as some of them did and then died from snakebites.

Yah made the world

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning **God created the heaven and the earth.**

Yahshua made the world

John 1:1,10,14

He was in the world, and **the world was made by him**, and the world knew him not.

Yah says only He is to be worshiped

Only Yah is worthy of worship and idolators will surely be punished.

I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. “You shall have no other gods before Me. “You shall not make for yourself a carved image - any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God,

Exodus 20:2-5

for you shall worship no other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God,

Exodus 34:14

People worship Yahshua

*Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he **worshiped** Him.*
John 9:38

*And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and **my God!**"*
John 20:28

No angel, or man, who was godly ever accepted worship from men even when they were mistaken. A good example of this is when Paul was in Athens (Acts 14:12) and the people cried out they are gods, they responded quickly and re-soundly, "we are men like yourselves."

From the beginning of His life, the Scriptures make clear Yahshua was indeed worshiped by men. Matthew 2:2 saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to **worship Him**."

All through His ministry people worshiped him Matthew 8:2-3: "And behold, a leper came and **worshiped Him**, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." Then Jesus (Yahshua) put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Some worshiped him for who He was, before he did any miracle, others worshiped Him afterwards.

Matthew 9:18

“While He spoke these things to them, behold, a ruler came and **worshiped Him**, saying, “My daughter has just died, but come and lay Your hand on her and she will live.”

The same word used for worshiping the Almighty is the same word used for worshiping Yahshua. This word for worship in Greek is *proskeneo*; the same word used for worshiping the true God and for the worship of false Gods. It does not mean one thing for one, and another thing for the other. In Hebrew it is Shawkaw which means to prostrate down bow worship (Genesis 24:26, 48, 52; Genesis 22:5).

Matthew 14:33

Then those who were in the boat came and **worshiped Him**, saying, “Truly You are the Son of God.”

Why? Because the ‘Son of God’ is God in the flesh.

The Bible teaches that Yahshua was not only worshiped, but was openly and directly **called the Almighty** by Thomas. In John 20:28 after Yahshua tells Thomas, who had doubted, to put his fingers in the holes made by the crucifixion, Thomas states “My Lord my God.” Instead of being corrected or rebuked for this statement (*which would be blasphemy if false*), Thomas is commended and blessed by Yahshua.

Yahshua is the Almighty Father manifest in flesh!

Isaiah 7:14

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

Isaiah 9:6

For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Micah 5:2

“But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting.”

John 1:1, 10, 14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him....And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Yahshua said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father?’

Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

John 20:28

And Thomas answered and said unto him, My LORD and my God.

2 Corinthians 5:19

that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Salvation is a gift that we receive by faith. We cannot earn it through our deeds or works. We cannot obtain it by being a “good person” or by attending church. Yahshua earned it for us by dying for our sins on the cross.

“Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”

Acts 4:12

My friend, everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved; so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

Here is a simple prayer that you can repeat for salvation:

Yahshua, I believe You died on the cross for my sins. I ask You to be my Savior. Thank You

If you just prayed this prayer, congratulations! You are saved and you are a new creation in Him!

Therefore if any man be in Messiah, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

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Yahshua Ministries - What I Believe

1. YAH

The Almighty Father's name in the Old Testament

YAH - Psalm 68:4; Isaiah 12:2; Isaiah 26:4; Revelation 19:1, 3, 4, 6 (see page 5).

YAH-WEH means, 'YAH - The Self-Existent one' (I AM).

I believe in a strict Monotheism. I do not believe the Almighty is 'three persons.'

I believe the Almighty is numerically one.

2. YAHSHUA

The Almighty Father's highest name revealed - New Testament

Yahshua is the name above every name!

Yahshua literally means, 'YAH is Salvation'.

3. The Bible

I believe the Bible to be the inspired word of Yahshua and to be free from error in the original manuscripts when all grammatical, historical, literary and cultural issues have been considered. I believe the Bible is the only Yahshua-given authority which man possesses; therefore, all doctrine, faith, hope, and all instruction for the church must be based upon and harmonize with the Bible.

4. Yahshua, the Messiah

I believe the Almighty Father of the Old Testament, became a man in the person of Yahshua, the Messiah. I believe the name Yahshua, meaning 'Yah is salvation,' is the Name above all names. Yahshua, is both fully the Almighty and fully man. He is the visible image of the Almighty Father. Yahshua's deity is none other than that of the Father. As it pertains to His humanity, Yahshua was born of a virgin in time.

5. The Holy Spirit

I believe that the Holy Spirit is none other than the Spirit of Yahshua Himself.

6. Salvation

Salvation is a gift that we receive by faith. We cannot earn it through our deeds or works. We cannot obtain it by being a “good person” or by attending church. Yahshua (“God manifested in the flesh” 1 Timothy 3:16) earned it *for us* through His death, burial and resurrection. It’s a gift that’s been made available to everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua.

7. The Second Coming

I believe that Yahshua died for our sins, was resurrected and ascended into heaven where he presently reigns. I also believe in a literal, bodily return of Yahshua after a time of Great Tribulation, both to claim his bride and to execute judgment on an unbelieving world.

8. Final Judgment

I believe there is coming a time when all who ever lived will stand before Yahshua to be judged and that all who are not saved will be cast into the lake of fire.

I believe this judgment to be literal and eternal.

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
