

**Zechariah's prophecy fulfilled -
Yahshua MessiYah enters Jerusalem
riding on a donkey.
(Matthew 21:1 – 21:11)**

*"All this was done that it might be fulfilled
which was spoken by the prophet, saying:*

*"Tell the daughter of Zion,
'Behold, **your King is coming to you,**
Lowly, and **sitting on a donkey,**
A colt, the foal of a donkey.'*

Matthew 21:5



The Almighty Father says He will be pierced

*"And I will pour on the house of David and on the
inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and
supplication; then they will look on Me
whom they **pierced**."*

The Almighty Father ... Zechariah 12:10



This prophecy, regarding "whom they pierced" is remarkable because it is **The Almighty Father Himself** speaking.

The Almighty Father says clearly,

*"they will look on Me whom they **pierced**"*

It was **Yahshua MessiYah, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh who was pierced.**

The **invisible** Father manifested **Himself in flesh as our MessiYah** to **fulfill** 'the Law' on **our** behalf, and to **shed His blood for us** as **our** atoning sacrifice.

In Acts 20:28, The apostle Paul tells the church elders in Ephesus...

*"Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock,
among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers,
to shepherd the church of **God**
which **He** purchased with **His own blood**."*

Acts 20:28



The Almighty Father tells us in Isaiah 43:11

"there is no other Savior but Me."

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do **for us** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. **He fulfilled the demands of the Law as a perfect man of flesh**, so that **He** could be **our perfect sacrifice** and **'kinsman-redeemer'**!

On the cross **He** took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, paying **our** price and thereby making us **"holy, blameless"** and **"without a single fault"** in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

This is the gospel! **This is the Good News!**

Everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

Before we begin, let us understand these names

YAH is The Almighty Fathers name. **YAH** is **not** an abbreviated form of the Almighty Father's name; **YAH is** His name. (Psalm 68:4; Isaiah 12: 2; Isaiah 26:4; Revelation 19:1, 3, 4, 6) Hallelu-**YAH** means, Praise **YAH**.

*Sing to God, sing praises to His name,
Extol Him who rides on the clouds,
By His name **YAH**,
And rejoice before Him.*

Psalm 68:4

*Behold, God is my salvation,
I will trust and not be afraid;
For **YAH**, the LORD, is my strength and song;
He also has become my salvation.*

Isaiah 12:2

YAH-weh is a **compound** name which means, **YAH** - The Self Existent One (**I AM**). In the Old Testament The Almighty Father combined His name with the Hebrew word 'weh', which means 'the Self Existent One (**I AM**)'

YAH-shua is a **compound** name which means, **YAH** is Salvation. When The Almighty Father came to us **Himself** manifested in flesh, He combined His name with His highest descriptor ever, the Hebrew word 'shua'. 'Shua' means, 'is salvation'. **YAH-shua** means, '**YAH** is Salvation'. This is the name **above every** name! (Philippians 2:9)

The Father says **He** is the **only Savior**, yet we know **YAH-shua MessiYah** **is the only Savior**.

Is The Almighty Father manifested in flesh our MessiYah?

YES! This is what the prophet Isaiah told us was going to happen; **The Almighty Father Himself** was going to come to us **in flesh** as our MessiYah!

*For unto us a **Child is born**,
Unto us a **Son** is given;*

*And the government will be upon His shoulder.
And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor,
Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
Isaiah 9:6*

Isaiah prophesied the **“Mighty God”** and **“Everlasting Father”** would come to us **Himself** as a **child born of flesh!**

We see Isaiah’s prophesy **fulfilled** in Matthew 1:23,

*“Behold, the virgin shall be **with child**, and bear **a Son**,
and they shall call **His name Immanuel**,”
which is translated, **“God with us.”**”*

Isaiah 9:6

*“unto us a **child is born**, Unto us a **Son**
is given...**His name** will be called...
Mighty God, Everlasting Father.”*

Matthew 1:23

*“the virgin shall be **with child**, and bear
a Son... they shall call **His name**...
“God with us.””*

Many fail to comprehend that The Almighty Father can be in Heaven filling the universe with His majesty and yet, **at the same time**, He can manifest **His** glory among us **in the tent of a human body**.

The Father tells us **He** is the **only savior**

*I, I am Yahweh, and **there is no other Savior**
but **Me**.*

Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but **Me**,
a righteous **God and Savior**.
There is none but **Me**.*

Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but **Me**;
For there is no savior besides Me.*

Hosea 13:4

YAH-shua is **“our God and Savior”**

Paul calls Yahshua,

“our great God and Savior”

Titus 2:13

Peter writes,

*“To those who have obtained like precious
faith with us by the righteousness of
our God and Savior Jesus Christ:*

2 Peter 1:1

Paul and Peter **knew** **The Almighty Father** had manifested **Himself** to us **as a man born of flesh**, just as Isaiah had prophesied.

“God was manifested in the flesh.”

Paul... 1 Timothy 3:16

There is only **one** King in The ‘Kingdom of God’ - The Almighty Father

The Scriptures **clearly** say that **The Almighty Father** is our **King**.

The Scriptures **clearly** say that **Yahshua MessiYah** is our **King**.

Does the ‘Kingdom of God’ have **two** Kings?

No, **The Almighty Father** is our **only** King.

The apostle Paul gives us understanding.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 8:6, **“for us there is one God, the Father.”**

Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:6 there is **“one God and Father of all.”**

Paul, then tells us our **“one God, the Father”**, manifested **Himself** in flesh.

“God was manifested in the flesh”

1 Timothy 3:16

(Notice that Paul **does not say**, Gods ‘son’ was manifested in the flesh.)

Paul says this of Yahshua MessiYah in Titus 2:13

*“looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing
of our great **God** and Savior
Jesus Christ” (Yahshua MessiYah)*

**Zechariah’s prophecy –
The King will ride into Jerusalem on a donkey**

*“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, **your King is coming to you**;
He is just and having salvation,
Lowly and **riding on a donkey**,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.*
