
In the Old Testament, a person teaching The Almighty's people to worship **'three distinct persons'** would have been put to death!

The Jewish people were warned continually to stay **far away** from pagan 'polytheism' by The Almighty Father **Himself**:

"Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God, the LORD is one!" Deuteronomy 6:4

What divides Jewish people from Trinitarianism is whether The Almighty is One (**singular**), or a composite of 'three persons'. The bedrock of Judaism has always been **true monotheism** - the belief that The Almighty is a **singular** One. This belief in **one singular** Almighty is what distinguished the Jewish people from their neighbors, who during antiquity were **polytheistic**.

The Jewish people have always safeguarded their **monotheism** against Trinitarian proselytizing. To them, the Catholic and Protestant 'Trinity Doctrine' is blasphemous, for they believe the 'trinity god' to be a **different** god than The Almighty God of Scripture.

How can the Jewish people (**or any Believer**) accept the 'Trinity Doctrine' which tells them The Almighty is comprised of 'three distinct persons', when this **refutes** the very words of **The Almighty Father Himself**?

In the Bible, false prophets claimed to speak the Word of God, but instead spread false teachings **contrary** to The Fathers own words. Any prophet who **contradicted** what The Almighty Father had previously revealed in His Word, **proved himself to be a false prophet**.

To **protect** His people, The Almighty Father commanded **false prophets** be put to death.

Isaiah's prophecy -
Our **"Mighty God"** and **"Everlasting Father"** would come to us manifested in flesh

This is what the prophet Isaiah **told us was going to happen!** The Almighty Father **Himself** was going to come to us born in flesh as a man!

*For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, **Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.*** Isaiah 9:6

Isaiah told us our **"Mighty God"** and **"Everlasting Father"** would come to us as a **"Son"** because He was going to be **"born" of a woman** and would be **a man made of flesh. He would be human!**

We see Isaiah's prophesy fulfilled in Matthew 1:23,

*"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a **Son**, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "**God with us.**"*

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do **for us** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. **He fulfilled the demands of the Law as a perfect man of flesh**, so that **He** could be **our perfect sacrifice, 'kinsman redeemer' and Savior!** On the cross **He** took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, paying **our** price and thereby making us **"holy, blameless"** and **"without a single fault"** in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

This is the gospel! **This is the Good News!** **Everyone** who calls upon the name of Yahshua **will be saved**, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

Most Protestant churches do not realize the 'Trinity Doctrine' they embrace comes directly from the Catholic church

The Almighty Father is the **only** Savior. He tells us this **Himself**.

*I, even I, am the LORD, And besides **Me** there is no savior.*
Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but **Me**, a righteous God and Savior. **There is none but Me.***
Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but **Me**;
For there is no savior besides Me.*
Hosea 13:4

These scriptures are clear, The Almighty Father says that **He** is the **only** Savior.

Many people however, discard the words of The Almighty Father, choosing instead to heed the words of their denomination which tells them a **'second person'** is their Savior, **not** the Father.

However, **nowhere** in the Bible does The Almighty Father speak of a 'second person' or a 'third person'.

Furthermore, **nowhere** in the Bible has any inspired writer ever said The Almighty is **'three persons'**. Moses certainly did not.

Who then came up with these terms and these ideas, which **contradict** the very words of The Almighty Father Himself?

Where did this teaching of a 'second' and a 'third person' come from?

The teaching of a 'second person' and a 'third person' came from the **Catholic church** when it formulated the 'Trinity Doctrine'.

The 'Trinity Doctrine' was enshrined by the **Catholic church** at the Council of Nicea in 325 AD.

Shortly thereafter, the Catholic church forced believers to accept the 'Trinity Doctrine' or face condemnation, excommunication and worse. It is well documented in history that multitudes of people were tortured and put to death for refusing to accept the 'Trinity Doctrine'. ***This fact alone should have sounded the alarm in the Christian world concerning the 'Trinity Doctrine'.***

Other **false** doctrines of the Catholic church

- The **"infallibility"** of the Catholic Church.
- **Catholic tradition** is **equal** to the **Bible**.
(*Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 82*).
- The **'Immaculate conception'** - Mary was born without sin and lived a sinless life.
- **Mary is the intercessor between God and man.**
- **The Assumption of Mary** - Mary never died.
- **Purgatory** - a place of suffering for sins not repented of before dying.
- **Indulgences** - paying money to the Catholic church to get your loved ones out of purgatory.
- **Praying to dead saints.**

How did the Protestant Church embrace this **Catholic Doctrine**?

*"At the time of the Reformation, **the Protestant Church took over the doctrine of the Trinity without serious examination.**"*

It is strangely ironic to hear Protestants disparage the 'Catholic church' for its many false doctrines, while being totally unaware that the 'Trinity Doctrine' they embrace **comes directly from the Catholic church.**

Now, **both Catholic and Protestant Churches pray to, and worship 'three distinct persons'**

The Catholic Pope Francis told people on January 11, 2015...

*"We usually **pray to Jesus**," Francis said.*

*"When we pray the Our Father, we **pray to the Father**. But we don't pray so much to the Holy Spirit. It is so important to **pray to the Holy Spirit**."*

Three quotes from well known **Protestant** websites:

1. *"So our one God is present in **three persons**: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. **This is the doctrine of the Trinity. It is appropriate to worship all three, and we should be careful to ensure that our worship of one person of the Trinity does not overshadow our worship of any other person of the Trinity.**"*

2. *"So, in general, pray to the Father; but occasionally, to express **their** Personhood and **your own love for them**, telling the Spirit and the Son that **you love them** and that **you would like them** to come in fullness is a good thing".*

3. *"There is only one God, eternally existing in **three persons**: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, Who are co-equal in their essential nature, attributes, and perfection; and **each of Whom is to be honored and worshiped as God**".*

Please look at the words used in these quotes

"It is appropriate to worship all three"

"their personhood" "your love for them"

"each is to be honored and worshiped as God"

Does this sound like **Biblical monotheism** to you?

Trinitarians will always emphatically say that there is one God. However, here is the deception. The Trinitarians one God, is **not** the **singular** Almighty of scripture. Their god is instead, **one being** that is comprised of **'three distinct persons, each fully God'**. These three **together**, make one god.

Trinitarians believe in, and **worship three divine figures** even though their lips are saying, "one God."

Trinitarians say that they are monotheistic and there is one God. However, their **actions** speak much louder than their words, for they **pray to three**, and they **worship three**. The **practical** reality is that Trinitarianism **is polytheistic**.

Reader, you **must** understand that even though you may go to a '**Protestant church**', **its very foundation** has nevertheless been **built upon the Catholic churches false 'Trinity Doctrine'**.
