## The Trinity Doctrine - a different Jesus

You happily put up with whatever anyone tells you, even if they preach a different Jesus than the one we preach, or a different kind of Spirit than the one you received, or a different kind of gospel than the one you believed.


The Apostle Paul... 2 Corinthians 11:4

Do Trinitarians preach "a different Jesus"?

<u>YES</u>, they most <u>certainly</u> do! The Apostle Paul taught Yahshua Messiah was The Almighty Father come manifested in flesh. Trinitarians <u>deny</u> that Yahshua Messiah is The Almighty Father come manifested in flesh. (They teach Yahshua is a 'second <u>distinct person</u>')

Is the 'Holy Spirit' Trinitarians preach, "a different kind of Spirit" than The Apostle Paul preached? <u>YES</u>, The Apostle Paul taught the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of The Almighty Father. Trinitarians deny the 'Holy Spirit' is the Spirit of The Almighty Father. (They preach The Holy Spirit is a 'third distinct person')

Trinitarians preach "a different Jesus" and "a different kind of Spirit" than the Apostle Paul preached. <u>Because of this</u>, Trinitarians are teaching "a different kind of gospel".



The Trinitarians 'Trinity Diagram'

The Apostle Paul taught that Yahshua Messiah was **The Almighty Father manifested in the flesh**. In the following scriptures, we see the Apostle Paul <u>literally interchanges</u> **Yahweh**, **The Almighty Father**, with **Yahshua Messiah**.

Romans 10:13 referencing Joel 2:32
1 Corinthians 1:31 referencing Jeremiah 9:24
1 Corinthians 2:16 referencing Isaiah 40:13
1 Corinthians 10:26 referencing Psalm 24:1
2 Corinthians 10:17 referencing Jeremiah 9:24

It is important to remember that <u>PRIOR</u> to Paul writing these scriptures (in which he <u>interchanges</u> Yahweh with Yahshua), he had been "caught up to the third heaven" where he received "<u>surpassingly great</u> <u>revelations</u>". (2 Corinthians 12:2-7)

## There is only one Great God

In the <u>Old</u> Testament **The Almighty Father** is called 'the Great God'. In the <u>New</u> Testament the Apostle Paul calls **Yahshua Messiah** our **Great God**.

Are there **two great God's?** 

No. The Almighty Father is the only 'great God'.

In the <u>Old</u> Testament, **The Almighty Father** is an <u>invisible</u> spirit. In the <u>New</u> Testament, **The Almighty Father** <u>is a visible man made of flesh</u>. The Apostle Paul told us that the <u>invisible</u> Father of the Old Testament <u>was manifested</u> (<u>made visible</u>) in <u>flesh</u>.

"God was manifested in the flesh"

1 Timothy 3:16

Notice, the Apostle Paul does not say God's 'son' was manifested in the flesh.

In Titus 2:13 the Apostle Paul <u>clearly identifies</u> <u>by name</u> who our <u>great</u> <u>God</u> and <u>only Savior</u> is.

looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ

## The Trinity Doctrine "a different kind of Spirit"

The Holy Spirit <u>is</u> the Spirit of The Almighty Father. Just as our spirit is not a different, or 'separate person' from ourself, neither is the Fathers spirit a different, or 'separate person' from Himself. Indeed, the Almighty makes this plain when He speaks of "My Spirit" (Isaiah 59:21).

In Romans 8:9, the Apostle Paul uses the phrase "the Spirit of God" and "the Spirit of Christ" interchangeably in the very same verse. This is because Paul knew that Yahweh and Yahshua Messiah are one and the same Spirit.

Trinitarians teach that the Holy Spirit is a 'third distinct person' in the Trinity Doctrine, and is not the Spirit of the Almighty Father. This is a false and unscriptural teaching that cannot be found anywhere in the Bible.

## The Trinity Doctrine "a different kind of gospel"

Trinitarians preach "a different Jesus" and "a different kind of Spirit" than the Apostle Paul preached. The Apostle Paul declares that <u>because</u> of <u>this</u>, they are preaching "a <u>different kind of gospel</u>".

The Old Testament tells us there is no Savior but the Father.

I, I am Yahweh, **and there is <u>no</u> <u>other Savior but Me</u>**.

Isaiah 43:11

For there is no other God but Me, a righteous God and Savior.

There is none but Me.

Isaiah 45:21

And you shall know no God but Me; For there is no savior besides Me.

Hosea 13:4

The Almighty Father <u>Himself</u> tells that <u>He is the only Savior</u>, therefore we <u>know</u> that Yahshua Messiah was The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

In Galatians 1: 8 the Apostle Paul says,

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let them be accursed.

The Apostle Paul gives this stern warning knowing "a different kind of gospel" would harm the Believer and the Church of God.

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
