

The Apostle Paul makes 'Oneness' **easy** to understand

In the Old Testament, **The Almighty Father** is an *invisible* spirit.

Paul tells us that the *invisible* Father of the Old Testament, came to us in the New Testament as a *visible* man manifested in flesh.

In the Old Testament **The Almighty Father** is called the 'great God'.

In the New Testament the Apostle Paul calls **Yahshua Messiah** our 'great God.'

Are there **two great God's**?

No, **The Almighty Father** is the **only** 'great God'.

The Apostle Paul gives us understanding.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 8:6, "**for us there is one God, the Father.**"

Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:6 there is "**one God and Father of all.**"

Paul then tells us our "**one God, the Father**" manifested Himself in flesh.

"God was manifested in the flesh"

1 Timothy 3:16

The Apostle Paul then clearly **identifies** this man **by His name**, and calls **Him our great God** and **only Savior**.
